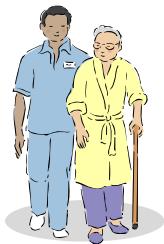

Description: Most of the care provided to the residents in nursing homes is done by the CNAs. The CNAs document this care on flow sheets, by report or in electronic kiosks. The information the CNA provides is used to complete the MDS by the facility nurses. The MDS is used in both the Medicare and Medicaid programs to determine the reimbursement levels for the facilities. Teaching the CNAs how this information is used to determine the correct RUG value for each resident will assist them in understanding the importance of accurate documentation. This session will educate the CNAs in nursing facilities about the MDS, what items are used in the calculation of the RUG scores. Attendees will understand how the RUG-III classification group is calculated for the RUG-III 53 and 34 group models. The late loss activities of daily living will be discussed and examples provided on how accuracy in coding affects the reimbursement levels for both Medicaid and Medicare Case Mix Payment Systems.

Learning Objectives:

- Understand the development of the Resource Utilization Groups (RUG-III) classification system used in the Medicaid Case Mix Reimbursement System and the Medicare Prospective Payment System.
- Determine how the RUG-III 53 and 34 classification groups are calculated from the Minimum Data Set (MDS) assessment.
- Value the importance of accurate completion of the MDS in a RUG-based case mix payment system.
