Overview

PREPARE is an award winning national disaster preparedness initiative created by Mather LifeWays Institute on Aging, designed to provide long-term care and senior living communities with the competencies needed to respond to any natural or man-made disaster or emergency.

Key Presentation Objectives

- Increase participant understanding of emergency preparedness and to enhance awareness to the importance of identifying the community services LTC may require during a public health emergency.
- Recognize the vulnerabilities and risks older adults experience during a disaster and become familiar with strategies for dealing with their special needs.
- Better understand the challenges facing LTC communities associated with pandemic preparedness and a pandemic's potential impact on services.
- Increase understanding of the Incident Command System and associated roles therefore those who care for vulnerable populations may know and realize the benefits of this nationally accepted method for managing emergency situations. Improve ability to structure disaster preparedness committees and plans by using the Incident Command System.
- Better understand the importance of a comprehensive disaster plan for long-term care communities and the steps necessary to develop an effective disaster plan that focuses on the "all-hazards" approach to planning, surveillance, response, mitigation, and recovery.

Presentation materials include a CD-ROM which contains a disaster plan guidance document to assist your community when planning and preparing to meet the needs of your residents and staff.
